Provide Enrichment when needed

Enrichment

Teachers are challenging and providing enrichment consistently for all students.

Examples:

Math: Acceleration, 3 in 2, Pretesting, Story problems, IXL, Challenge Questions.

Social Studies: Analyzing Primary Sources, Cause & Effect questions, Simulations

Science: STEM robotics (Ozobots), Experiments, Genius Hour, Clubs

Language Arts/Reading: Writing contests, Public Speaking, Reading within Lexile Levels, IXL

Specials: 3D printing, Concerts, Personal fitness goals, Band Competitions, ELP program
